VILLAGE & TOWN OF PERRY SHARED SERVICES STUDY

The Village and Town of Perry are undertaking a shared municipal services study. The purpose of the study is to find ways to reduce the cost of providing municipal services. Often municipalities can share services with each other and with other neighboring municipalities as a means to reduce their operating costs.
