STAFF & SAFETY

YMCA Day Camps, including the Perry Summer Rec Program, are directed by full-time YMCA professionals and staffed with dedicated, enthusiastic and passionate staff. Staff are selected for maturity, understanding, patience and a sincere interest in working with youth. All staff complete an application process including an interview, reference and background checks. Staff complete an extensive orientation before the program begins. Your child's safety and health are our main concern. All staff are certified in First Aid and CPR and are trained in risk management and emergency procedures. Certified lifeguards supervise all aquatic activities and our campers use the "buddy system" so that they are accounted for at all times.

CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT

The Summer Rec Program provides more than just a safe, fun place to be. The Summer Rec Program, like all YMCA youth programs, is founded on the YMCA's four core values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility. Character Development gives focus to everything we do at the YMCA and at summer day camp.
